## 2015/2016 BEA Parent-Child Reading Programme Kicks Off

Hong Kong, 13<sup>th</sup> November, 2015 – The Bank of East Asia, Limited ("BEA") announces that The Bank of East Asia Charitable Foundation Limited ("BEA Foundation") and the Hong Kong Sheng Kung Hui's Religious Education Resource Centre ("RERC") have kicked off the 2015/2016 BEA Parent-Child Reading Programme ("the Programme"). The BEA Foundation is serving as title sponsor of the Programme for the third consecutive year. In addition, a seminar was held this year after the ceremony with the support of Metro Broadcast.

Over 200 guests attended the kick-off ceremony cum seminar, held on Saturday, 7<sup>th</sup> November, 2015 at BEA Tower in Kwun Tong. In addition to participating parents, educators also attended the seminar to share their views and experiences on how parent-child reading can help parents strengthen their relationships with their children, and foster an interest in reading among children.

Speaking at the event, Mr. Tong Hon-shing, Deputy Chief Executive of BEA and Director of the BEA Foundation, said, "In view of the overwhelming response to the Programme in the past two years, we have decided to extend the programme to kindergartners, increasing the number of openings from 2,000 to 2,400, so that more families can participate in this meaningful programme."

The Rev. Dr. Canon Thomas Pang, Director of RERC, one of the guest speakers in the seminar, said "This year, the number of participating schools increased to 106 from 64 in the previous year. This is indeed an encouraging result to us."
