Hong Kong, 3rd November, 2022 – The Hong Kong Fencing Association ("HKFA") today announced that the 'BEA x Blue Cross 2022 Hong Kong Open Fencing Championships' will be held on 3rd and 4th of December, 2022, co-sponsored by The Bank of East Asia, Limited ("BEA") and Blue Cross (Asia-Pacific) Insurance Limited ("Blue Cross").

In the run up to the tournament, a photography and memorabilia exhibition titled "Pursuing Dreams, Creating Legends" will run from 4th to 6th November, 2022 at Festival Walk. The launch ceremony, held earlier today, was officiated by Mr Wally Yeung, Chairman of the Hong Kong Fencing Association, Mr Adrian Li, Co-Chief Executive of BEA and Ms Bonnie Tse, Chief Executive Officer of Blue Cross.

Elite fencers Mr Edgar Cheung Ka Long and Mr Shawn Cheung Siu Lun attended the ceremony and were joined by a group of young fencing athletes, including Ms Daphne Chan Lok Sze, top Female Junior Foil Fencer, Ms Sit Summer Fay, gold medallist in the 2022 Asian Under-23 Fencing Championships Women's Team Sabre, Ms Janelle Leung Ya Lei, gold medallist in the 2022 Asian Junior & Cadet Fencing Championships Women's Foil and Mr Royce Chan Lok Hei, ranked first Male Junior Sabre Fencer. All of them will take part in the upcoming 'BEA x Blue Cross 2022 Hong Kong Open Fencing Championships' in December, under the leadership of Mr Zheng Kang Zhao, Head Coach of the Hong Kong Fencing Team.

The exhibition will display memorabilia, including the game-worn fencing shoes of Mr Edgar Cheung Ka Long, the fencing glove worn by Mr Shawn Cheung Siu Lun, as well as other items such as fencing blades and chest protectors used by the Hong Kong Fencing Team members, to promote fencing to the local community. In addition, a total of eight fencing workshops will be organised with the aim of increasing youth participation in the sport.





"We are excited to have BEA and Blue Cross Insurance as our co-title sponsors this year. The BEA x Blue Cross 2022 Hong Kong Open Fencing Championships will be held on 3rd and 4th December, 2022. In addition to the senior category, this year's event will include the under-14 category so that both adults and young fencers can participate.
