# Notice to Customers on Making Payments to/Receiving Payments from Third Parties

In order to enhance our customer experience, the Bank has instituted established good practices in handling requests from customers ("Transferors")<sup>1</sup> for the return of payments made to third parties ("Transferees")<sup>2</sup> by mistake ("Mis-Transfer of Funds")<sup>3</sup>.

- Notice to "Transferors" and "Transferees":
  - 1. Transferors: When making payments to third parties, Transferors are advised to provide accurate information and are reminded to be careful to avoid errors.
  - 2. Transferees: If mis-transferred funds are received, Transferees are advised to promptly authorise the Bank to return the funds in question; otherwise, there is the potential for criminal liability.

# • How to Report a Mis-Transfer of Funds:

- 1. Visit a BEA branch directly and request the "Mis-Transfer of Funds Refund Request Form". Complete and submit the form with the required documents.
- Download the "Mis-Transfer of Funds Refund Request Form" from the following webpage, and submit it with the required documents by post or directly to any BEA branch in Hong Kong: https://www.hkbea.com/html/en/bea-application-forms.html

# • Next Steps for Transferor's Mis-Transfer of Funds:

Upon receipt of a completed "Mis-Transfer of Funds - Refund Request Form", the Bank will provide the Transferor with:

- 1. a written acknowledgement by mail or e-mail by the next working day.
- 2. a final written response by mail or email within 20 working days.
