13th November, 2019

- The Dow Jones Industrial Average stayed unchanged and closed at 27,691.49, while the NASDAQ composite rose 21.81 points, or 0.26%, to 8,486.09.
- US stocks edged higher as investors measured the likelihood of a partial trade deal between China and the US. US president Donald Trump said that no agreement would mean significant tariff increases.
- Facebook Inc. surged as it announced a new payment feature. Walt Disney Co. rose after its much-anticipated streaming service debuted.
- The Federal Reserve Bank of Philadelphia president Patrick Harker said that he was against the US central bank's interest-rate cut last month and he added that officials should now wait and see how the economy evolves before acting again. Harker is not a voter this year on the rate-setting Federal Open Market Committee.
- UK recorded a drop in employment of 58,000 for the 3 months from July to September, the biggest drop since 2015. The job figures provide further evidence that Brexit uncertainty is finally hitting the labour market.
- According to Morgan Stanley, crude prices, which are now trading at about US\$62 a barrel in London, may tumble by almost 30% to US\$45 a barrel if the OPEC and its allies do not announce deeper production cutbacks. Citigroup Inc. and BNP Paribas predict a slide to below US\$50.
- Oil ended slightly lower last night amid concern that US president Donald Trump may expand his trade offensive, multiplying the economic headwinds already threatening global energy demand.
- Safe heavens rose. The Japanese yen and Swiss franc were the top performers among the major currencies. The New Zealand dollar tumbled ahead of the rate decision by the Reserve Bank of New Zealand.









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Historical Performance
