- The Dow Jones Industrial Average dropped 244.56 points, or 0.88%, to 27,657.42, while the NASDAQ composite dropped 116.99 points, or 1.07%, to 10,793.28.
- Technology shares dragged the US stock market to a six-week low as investors searched for new catalysts to give direction to global markets.
- The Trump administration's curbs on WeChat were put on hold by a judge, upending an effort
 to halt use of the Chinese-owned app in the US. US Magistrate Judge Laurel Beeler of San
 Francisco issued a preliminary injunction at the request of a group of US WeChat users, who
 argued the prohibitions would violate the free-speech rights of millions of Chinese-speaking
 Americans who rely on it.
- The Bank of England's preparations for the aftermath of a potentially messy Brexit could include using negative interest rates by the end of the year. Economists at Goldman Sachs Group Inc. and Bank of America Global Research expect a failure to reach a trade deal with the European Union to be among the factors pushing the BoE to cut rates to below zero.
- The initial value of the September Consumer Confidence Index conducted by University of Michigan is at a six-month high.
- Billionaire Jack Ma's Ant Group won approval to list in Shanghai, clearing a key hurdle as the company prepares for what could become the world's largest initial public offering.
- Oil prices have seen the biggest weekly increase since June. Saudi Arabia hinted that it is ready for new production cuts and lashed out at OPEC+ members which it claims cheated in complying with the production quotas.









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






Dow Jones Industrial Average
