Daily Market News

18th January, 2021

- The Dow Jones Industrial Average fell 177.26 points, or 0.57%, to 30,814.26, while the NASDAQ composite fell 114.14 points, or 0.87%, to 12,998.50.
- US president-elect Joe Biden's US\$1.9 trillion economic relief proposal serves as the opening salvo in a legislative battle that could be prolonged by the go-big price tag and the inclusion of initiatives opposed by many Republicans.
- Federal Reserve Bank of Boston president Eric Rosengren said US president-elect Joe Biden's request for US\$1.9 trillion in economic relief is needed as growth shows signs of slowing. The current mix of fiscal and monetary policy is appropriate, and it is a suitable time for fiscal support as interest rates are close to zero.
- US retail sales decreased 0.7% in December from the previous month, following a downwardly revised 1.4% drop in November. The unadjusted value of sales increased just 0.6% in 2020 compared with a year earlier.
- The US producer price index (PPI) climbed 0.3% in December from a month earlier, following a 0.1% gain in November. The PPI advanced 0.8% from a year earlier. Core PPI increased 0.1% from a month earlier, missing estimates, and was up 1.2% from a year earlier.
- The University of Michigan's preliminary consumer sentiment index fell to 79.2 in January, down from 80.7 last month. The index added to signs that consumers may be growing less optimistic as vaccinations begin to be rolled out amid soaring new infections.
- Several European Central Bank officials said the full effect of the pandemic crisis on euro-area banks has yet to be felt as policy support has so far masked losses.





Historical Performance




Dow Jones Industrial Average
