### **Daily Market News**

26th March, 2021

- The Dow Jones Industrial Average rose 199.42 points, or 0.62%, to 32,619.48, while the NASDAQ composite index rose 15.79 points, or 0.12%, to 12,977.68.
- US President Biden said he plans to run for re-election in 2024, resolving for now uncertainty about his future political intentions.
- US Federal Reserve Chair Powell said the US central bank would wait until the economy has "all but fully recovered" to pull back the extraordinary monetary support it has rolled out in response to the Covid-19 pandemic.
- Applications for US unemployment benefits fell to the lowest in a year, indicating improvement in the labour market as more Americans get Covid-19 vaccinations and business restrictions are eased in many states.
- President Biden's Treasury Department is calling for a "more robust minimum tax" on profits earned by American corporations overseas to remove incentives for companies to shift earnings outside US borders.
- The People's Bank of China reiterated the need to keep prudent monetary policy flexible and appropriate, according to a statement published after a quarterly meeting of its monetary policy committee on Wednesday.
- US exports were down 32% in February from the previous month, but up 54% from February of last year, according to a statement on the Census Bureau website.
- China's central bank said its planned digital currency will co-exist with technology platforms like Ant Group Co.'s Alipay and Tencent Holdings Ltd.'s WeChat Pay, which currently dominate the online payments market.







**EUR/USD Daily Chart** 


