- The Dow Jones Industrial Average rose 98.49 points, or 0.30%, to 33,171.37, while the NASDAQ composite index fell 79.08 points, or 0.60%, to 13,059.65.
- US stocks dropped from record highs as investors weighed the potential fallout from forced block sales in the rest of Wall Street. Boeing Co. lifted the Dow Jones Industrial Average to another all-time high after the aircraft maker announced a large order.
- President Biden plans to announce that 90% of US adults will be eligible to get a Covid-19 vaccine in three weeks, and that his administration will more than double the number of pharmacies where shots are available, officials familiar with the matter said.
- Wall Street banks grappling with the implosion of Bill Hwang's investment firm spent Monday briefing US regulators as Washington starts to dig into one of the biggest fund blow-ups in years.
- BYD Co., the Chinese electric-vehicle maker in which Warren Buffett's Berkshire Hathaway holds a stake, said profit more than doubled last year thanks to a recovery in demand in the world's biggest car market.
- Oil prices climbed to the highest in almost two weeks as traders looked ahead to this week's OPEC+ meeting, with speculation mounting that renewed concerns about demand will cause the group to keep production in check.
- The US dollar lost some of its earlier gains amid improving risk sentiment as shipping traffic started moving in the Suez Canal and investors looked toward President Biden's unveiling of an infrastructure and jobs plan this week.






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Historical Performance




Dow Jones Industrial Average




EUR/USD Daily Chart
